EXPORT CONTROL (SANCTIONS ETC) (No.3) ORDER 2014

In exercise of his powers under sections 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 of the Export Control Act 2005, the Minister has made the following Order for the purposes of implementing Council Implementing Regulation (EU) No 1054/2013 of 30 October 2013, Council Implementing Regulation (EU) No 740/2014 of 8 July 2014, Council Implementing Regulation (EU) 1159/2014 of 30 October 2014 implementing Article 8(1) of Regulation (EC) No 765/2006 concerning restrictive measures against Belarus and Corrigendum to Council Implementing Regulation (EU) No 740/2014 of 8 July 2014–

Title and commencement.

1. This Order may be cited as the Export Control (Sanctions etc) (Amendment No.3) Order 2014 and comes into operation on the day of publication.

Amendment to Schedule 4 of the Export Control (Sanctions Etc.) Order 2005.

2. Schedule 4 to the Export Control (Sanctions etc) Order 2005 is amended by substituting the list of persons and entities after the heading–

“Belarus

Persons and entities listed in Council Regulation (EU) 765/2006 as amended from time to time.”
