In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 59 of the Medical and Health Act 1997 and all other enabling powers, the Minister for Health has made the following Rules.

Title and commencement.

1. These Rules may be cited as the Hospital Rules 2006 and come into operation on the day appointed by the Minister by notice in the Gazette.

Interpretation.

2. In these Rules, unless the context otherwise requires-

"accommodation" includes, nursing, dressings, medicines and food;

- "Authority" means the Gibraltar Health Authority established by section 3 of the Medical (Gibraltar Health Authority) Act, 1987;
- "EEA EFTA separation agreement" has the same meaning as in section 3(1) of the European Union (Withdrawal Agreement) Act 2020;

"entitled person" means-

- (a) a person registered in accordance with section 4 of the Medical (Group Practice Scheme) Act as a member of the Medical Group Practice Scheme;
- (b) a national of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland who is covered by-
 - the Exchanges of Despatches concerning Reciprocal Health Care and Social Security Arrangement between the United Kingdom and Gibraltar made in January 1974 and published as Miscellaneous No. 11 of 1974;
 - (ii) the memorandum of understanding signed in June 1997 between the Government of Gibraltar and the Government of the United Kingdom in respect of health care under the health care system in Gibraltar for United Kingdom social security pensioners resident in Gibraltar; or
 - (iii) any such reciprocal arrangement or understanding that takes place between the Government of Gibraltar and the Government of any other British Overseas Territory or Crown Dependency in respect of health care under the health care system in Gibraltar for the citizens of that territory or dependency; or

- (c) a national of an EEA State or Switzerland exercising rights in accordance with-
 - (i) Title III of Part 2 of the withdrawal agreement;
 - (ii) Title III of Part 2 of the EEA EFTA separation agreement; or
 - (iii) the social security provisions of the Swiss citizens' rights agreement;
- (d) a person exercising rights in accordance with a listed healthcare arrangement pursuant to regulation 9 of the Healthcare (European Economic Area and Switzerland Arrangements) (EU Exit) Regulations 2020;

"hospital" means any hospital provided or maintained by the Authority;

"hospital treatment" means hospital care including drugs and diagnostics;

"in-patient" means a patient who occupies a hospital bed for a material time;

"Medical Director" means the person appointed as such under section 10A of the Medical (Gibraltar Health Authority) Act, 1987;

"medical officer" means a medical practitioner employed in the hospital by the Authority;

- "non-entitled person" means any person other than an entitled person;
- "out-patient" means a patient other than an in-patient who receives hospital care;
- "patient" includes an expectant or nursing mother or the baby of such mother;
- "Swiss citizens' rights agreement" has the same meaning as in section 3(1) of the European Union (Withdrawal Agreement) Act 2020;
- "withdrawal agreement" has the same meaning as in section 3(1) of the European Union (Withdrawal Agreement) Act 2020.

Admission of patients.

3.(1) Any entitled person who, in the opinion of the Medical Director or any other medical officer in the hospital authorised by him, is in need of hospital treatment, shall be entitled to be admitted to a hospital either as an in-patient or as an out-patient for the purpose of receiving hospital treatment free of charge.

(2) Except in cases of emergency, a non-entitled person shall not be admitted to a hospital for the purpose of receiving medical attention or treatment, as an in-patient or as an out-patient, without the permission of the Medical Director or any other medical officer in the hospital authorised by him, and the Medical Director or such medical officer may grant or refuse such permission in his discretion.

Form to be completed by patient.

3A. The Authority may prescribe any form to be completed by a person admitted to hospital for the purpose of receiving hospital treatment.

Fees payable by non-entitled person.

4.(1) In respect of a non-entitled person who receives hospital treatment, there shall be payable the fees set out in the third column of Schedule 1.

(2) The fees referred to in subrule (1) must be revised annually in accordance with the Index of Retail Prices published by the Government Statistician.

(3) The first revision under this rule shall apply as from 1 April 2018 and shall apply the Index of Retail Prices as at that date, and subsequent revisions shall apply on each subsequent 1 April and apply the Index of Retail Prices prevailing on that date of that year.

(4) Any figure revised pursuant to subrule (2) shall be rounded up to the next whole penny.

Fees payable by out-patients.

5. An entitled person referred by a private clinic for diagnostic services conducted at or in connection with a hospital shall pay, only for those diagnostic services which are specified in the description of service No. 5, 6, 7, 10 and 11 in column 1 of Schedule 1, the fees set out against those services in column 3 of that Schedule.

Payment and recovery of fees.

6.(1) A person who is liable to pay any fees under these Rules shall sign a consent for payment in the form of contract as set out in Schedule 3.

(2) The fees payable under these Rules shall be due and payable on demand.

(3) Except in cases of emergency, any fee which may be charged in respect of any in-patient or out-patient shall be paid before that person receives any medical care.

(4) The Medical Director may require that a non-entitled person who has applied to be admitted to a hospital as an in-patient shall give such security as the Medical Director may deem sufficient for the payment of any fees which becomes payable in respect of such person under the provisions of these Rules.

(5) The Medical Director may refuse to admit to the hospital any person-

- (a) in respect of whom the security referred to in sub-rule (3) has not been given, or
- (b) who refused to sign the consent form referred to in sub-rule (1).

(6) All sums due and remaining unpaid in respect of fees prescribed by these rules shall be recoverable as a civil debt by the Authority from the person-

- (a) in respect of whom they are payable,
- (b) who is responsible for the payment of such fees,
- (c) on whose application that person was admitted to the hospital, or
- (d) who was provided with any treatment specified in the Schedule 1 or 2.

(7) Any fees due and remaining unpaid shall be recoverable under subrule (6) notwithstanding that subrules (1) and (3) have not been complied with.".

Assessment of accommodation fees.

7. In assessing the fees due under these rules in respect of accommodation the day of admission and the day of discharge shall be treated as a single day.

Removal of persons from hospital in certain cases.

8. Any person who enters a hospital as a patient or visitor or for any other reason may be removed from the hospital by direction of the Medical Director if–

- (a) that person fails to comply with any directions given to him by a medical officer;
- (b) that person refuses to leave the hospital after being medically discharged; or

(c) that person's conduct is such that, in the opinion of the Medical Director, his continued presence in the hospital is prejudicial to the comfort or well being of other patients or to the general administration of the hospital.

Remission of fees.

9. The Medical Director may-

- (a) because of the financial circumstances of the patient, or
- (b) for any other good cause shown,

remit in writing any fees payable under these Rules, in whole or in part.

Visits to patients.

10. Visits to patients in a hospital may be made only at such times and for such periods as the Medical Director may direct by order in writing.

Delegation of powers.

11. The Medical Director may delegate in writing to such person as the Minister may approve-

- (a) the power to decide whether any person is an entitled person or a non-entitled person; or
- (b) any other powers vested in him by these Rules.

Theatre procedure.

- 12. Theatre procedures shall be classified into the following groups as set out in Schedule 2-
 - (a) minor,
 - (b) intermediate,
 - (c) major, and
 - (d) major+.

13. There shall be no entitlement to free medicines for non-entitled out patients.

Cost of appliances.

14.(1) The cost of appliances provided for non-entitled patients shall be met by the patient concerned.

(2) In other cases the patient's share of the cost of the appliances shall be determined by the Authority by policy to be made from time to time.

Private diagnostic investigations.

15. The results of private diagnostic investigations shall form part of the private medical record owned by the person who paid for such investigation.

Payment for maternity care.

16.(1) Subject to sub-rule (5), once a non-entitled obstetric patient has made appropriate financial arrangements for her maternity care in the hospital in accordance with these Rules, she shall be entitled to the same package of maternity care that is received by an entitled obstetric patient.

(2) Where a non-entitled obstetric patient is accepted for registration as an obstetric patient, she shall receive no maternity care unless–

- (a) he fee set out in column 3 of Schedule 1 for maternity in column 1 of that Schedule is paid; and
- (b) the Non-entitled Patient Contract Form referred to in rule 6(1) is signed,

by that patient or any other person who takes the responsibility for paying the costs on behalf of that patient.

(4) Where the non-entitled obstetric patient does not want to complete the whole package of the maternity care, no part of the fees paid under this rule shall be refundable.

(5) Where it appears to the consultant that the baby of a non-entitled obstetric patient may require neonatal intensive care, the consultant or the Authority may, due to the limited facility for neonatal intensive care in the hospital, advise the patient not to book for delivery in the hospital and to make an arrangement for delivery elsewhere in order to have appropriate neonatal intensive care.

- (6) Where a non-entitled obstetric patient or the baby is required-
 - (a) to be transferred to a hospital or clinic outside Gibraltar; or
 - (b) to be treated for a complication or additional medical condition other than the usual care for a normal pregnancy and delivery,

the Authority shall not be responsible for covering the costs incurred in connection with the above situation and the non-entitled obstetric patient shall make further arrangement for payment of such costs.

(7) Midwifery follow up shall be available up to 28 days post partum, including neonatal screening for the baby, with the exception that domiciliary visits shall not be provided to an address outside Gibraltar.

(8) In this rule, "non-entitled obstetric patient" means a non-entitled expectant or nursing mother.

Revocation.

17. The Hospital Rules are revoked.
