THE CONSTITUTION OF GIBRALTAR

PARTICULARS DIRECTIONS UNDER SECTION 48

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 48 of the Constitution and of all other enabling powers, and acting after consultation with the Chief Minister, the Governor has charged the Ministers specified in the Schedule hereto with responsibility for the business of the Government relating to the defined domestic matters specified in relation to those Ministers.

The Direction under section 48 of the Constitution of 1st December 2003 is revoked.
