#### EU Legislation/International Agreements involved:

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 92 of the Traffic Act, and all other enabling powers, the Governor has made the following regulations-

#### Title.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Traffic (Catalan Bay Road) Regulations 2003.

#### Interpretation.

2. For the purposes of these regulations "Catalan Bay Road" means the Catalan Bay Road from the junction with Sir Herbert Miles Road to the Sea Wave premises.

#### **Restrictions on driving.**

3. Subject to regulation 4, no person shall drive, cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle or motorcycle or ride any bicycle in a southerly direction along Catalan Bay Road between the hours of 11.00am and 7.00pm on Mondays to Fridays (inclusive) and between the hours of 10.00am and 7.00pm on Saturdays, Sundays and Bank and Public Holidays

### **TRAFFIC (CATALAN BAY ROAD) REGULATIONS 2003**

during the period commencing with the second Saturday in June and ending with the second Sunday in September in each year.

#### **Exceptions.**

- 4. These regulations shall not apply to-
  - (a) ambulances, fire engines, police vehicles, customs vehicles, disabled permit holders, residents authorised to park in the area under the Parking and Waiting Order and such other vehicles as the Minister may, in writing, authorise for a specific purpose; and
  - (b) goods vehicles, delivering goods or merchandise to premises in Catalan Bay Village between the hours of 11.00am and 12 noon on Mondays to Fridays (inclusive) and between the hours of 10.00am and 12 noon on Saturdays, Sundays and Bank and Public Holidays during the period specified in regulation 3.
