AN ACT to amend the Social Security (Employment Injuries Insurance) Act.

ENACTED by the Legislature of Gibraltar.

Title and commencement.

1. This Act may be cited as the Social Security (Employment Injuries Insurance) (Amendment) Act 2007 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1 July 2006.

Amendment of the Social Security (Employment Injuries Insurance) Act.

2. The Social Security (Employment Injuries Insurance) Act is amended in section 5 as follows—

- (a) the existing provisions of section 5 becomes sub-section (1);
- (b) the following is inserted after sub-section (1)—

“(2) No insured person over the age of 60 or one who has retired at age 55 by operation of law shall be liable to make contributions pursuant to the provisions of this Act. For the avoidance of doubt, nothing in this sub-section affects the application of sub-section (1) as it applies to employers.”

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill amends the Social Security (Employment Injuries Insurance) Act to exempt persons over 60 years of age or one who has retired at age 55 by operation of law from paying contributions.

This implements the Government's 2006 budget commitments.
