JUDGMENT

The Claimant filed a Claim Form on 2 October 2025 claiming breach of employment contract seeking arrears of pay, arrears of notice pay and arrears of holiday pay in the total sum of £11,576.93.

Pursuant to Rule 13 of the Employment Tribunal (Constitution and Procedure) Rules 2016 (**the Rules**), the accepted Claim was sent to the Respondent together with the prescribed Response Form on 3 October 2025.

The Respondent has not presented the Response within 21 days of 3 October 2025 or at all, nor made an Application for an extension of time for presenting the Response.

Pursuant to Rule 21, **I FIND THAT** on the available material (the Claim Form with attached employment contract and ETB Termination Form drafted on behalf of the Respondent), I am able to determine the Claim as follows:-

1. The Claimant's claim for breach of employment contract under the Employment Tribunal (Extension Of Jurisdiction) Order 2016 is well-founded and succeeds.
2. **THE CLAIMANT IS HEREBY AWARDED AND THE RESPONDENT IS HEREBY ORDERED TO PAY TO THE CLAIMANT the sum of £11,576.93 , within 21 days of the date of this Judgment (under Rule 56).**
