## ANIMALS ACT

### ANIMALS AND BIRDS (IMPORTATION) (LICENCE FEES) (AMENDMENT) RULES 2023

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 26 of the Animals Act the Minister has made the following Rules—

#### **Title.**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Animals and Birds (Importation) (Licence Fees) (Amendment) Rules 2023.

#### **Commencement.**

2. These Rules come into operation on the 1<sup>st</sup> August 2023.

#### **Amendment to rules.**

3. Substitute the Schedule in the Animals and Birds (Importation) (Licence Fees) Rules 1995 with the following—

#### FEES IN RESPECT OF IMPORT LICENCES FOR ANIMALS

<i>Animals and numbers in the consignment</i>	<i>Fee</i>
Importation of dogs, cats, horses and other animals requiring particular vaccination status	£17 per animal
Importation of birds:	
Under 10 in any one consignment	£ 6
10-50 in any one consignment	£17
Over 50 in any one consignment	£23

Importation of fish:		
	1-20 in any one consignment	£ 1.00
	Over 20 in any one consignment	£6
Others (hamsters, mice, chipmunks etc):		
	Under 5 in any one consignment	£ 1.00
	Over 5 in any one consignment	£ 6

”
