**CEMETERY ORDINANCE.**

**CEMETERY (AMENDMENT) RULES 1986.**

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 11 of the Cemetery Ordinance, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has made the following rules:

**Title and commencement.**

1.(1) These rules may be cited as the Cemetery (Amendment) Rules, 1986.

(2) These rules shall come into operation on the 1st day of May, 1986.

**Amendment of Schedule 2.**

2. Schedule 2 to the Cemetery Rules is amended by revoking Part I thereof, and substituting therefor the following new Part:

“I- Payable to the Keeper	Persons of or over 10 years £	Children under 10 years £
1. For interment in a vault.	24.00	13.50
2. For interment in an ordinary grave.	13.00	7.00
3. For interment of a still-born child in a vault.	-	13.50
4. For interment of a still-born child in an ordinary grave.	-	2.00
5. For interment in a vault or an ordinary grave from the undermentioned Institutions when a certificate is produced that the deceased was an inmate		

	and that the funeral is undertaken at the cost of the Institution:-

6.	For interment after the prescribed hours add 50% to fees as in Items Nos. 1 to 5		
7.	(a) For opening a vault	11.00	11.00

8.	For removal and transfer of remains from a vault or grave to a vault, grave or mortuary (where rearrangement of contents or drainage is not required or requested).

9.	For removal or rearrangement of remains in a vault if necessary or if required by owner (including drainage of water if required).	20.00	20.00
10.	For disinfectants used when vaults are opened (under Items Nos. 1-6) and when foundations of monuments are put in.	1.00	1.00
