CEMETERY (AMENDEMENT) RULES 1986.

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 11 of the Cemetery Ordinance, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has made the following rules:

Title and commencement.

1.(1) These rules may be cited as the Cemetery (Amendment) Rules, 1986.

(2) These rules shall come into operation on the 1st day of May, 1986.
