LEGAL NOTICE NO. 100 OF 2020.

CIVIL CONTINGENCIES ACT 2007

CIVIL CONTINGENCIES EMERGENCY (CORONAVIRUS No.2) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2020

In exercise of the powers conferred on her by section 11 of the Civil Contingencies Act 2007, and all other enabling powers, the Minister with responsibility for Civil Contingencies, acting with the consent of the Chief Minister, has made these Regulations-

Title.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Civil Contingencies Emergency (Coronavirus No.2) (Amendment) Regulations 2020.

Commencement.

2. These Regulations come into operation on the day of publication.

Statement in accordance with section 11(2) of the Act.

3. The Minister declares that –

- (a) there is an outbreak of Coronavirus which originated in Wuhan, China and the World Health Organisation statement of the second meeting of the International Health Regulations (2005) has stated that the outbreak now meets the criteria for a Public Health Emergency of International Concern; there are more than 97,000 confirmed cases globally and more than 3000 people have died so far, mainly in China; the virus has so far reached 87 countries, areas or territories, on 3 March 2020 one person was confirmed as having contracted the virus having travelled from Italy via Malaga, Spain, and it is therefore necessary to take measures to prevent, mitigate and control the spread of the virus in Gibraltar;
- (b) on 10th February the UK Government declared the spread of Coronavirus “a serious and imminent threat” and announced new measures to delay or prevent further transmission of the virus;
- (c) conditions in section 12 of the Act are met;
- (d) these regulations contain only provisions which are appropriate for the purpose of preventing, controlling or mitigating an aspect or effect of the emergency in respect of which the regulations are made; and

- (e) the effect of these regulations is in due proportion to that aspect or effect of the said emergency.

Amendment of the Civil Contingencies Emergency (Coronavirus No.2) Regulations 2020.

4. In the Schedule to the Civil Contingencies Emergency (Coronavirus No.2) Regulations 2020 for the entry “Italy: north (defined by a line above, and not including, Pisa, Florence and Rimini)” substitute “Italy”.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

These Regulations amend the Schedule to the Civil Contingencies Emergency (Coronavirus No.2) Regulations 2020 (“the Regulations”).

The Schedule currently applies the Regulations to an area comprised of the north of Italy. The amendment extends the application of the Regulations to the whole of Italy.
