## **CIVIL CONTINGENCIES ACT 2007**

### **CIVIL CONTINGENCIES EMERGENCY (CORONAVIRUS) (BUSINESSES, RESTRICTIONS AND OTHER MATTERS) (NO.13) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2022**

In exercise of the powers conferred on her by section 11 of the Civil Contingencies Act 2007, and all other enabling powers, the Minister with responsibility for Civil Contingencies, acting with the consent of the Chief Minister, has made these Regulations-

#### **Title.**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Civil Contingencies Emergency (Coronavirus) (Businesses, Restrictions and Other Matters) (No.13) (Amendment) Regulations 2022.

#### **Commencement.**

2. These Regulations come into operation on the day of publication.

#### **Statement in accordance with section 11(2) of the Act.**

3. The Minister declares that-

- (a) there is an outbreak of Coronavirus which on the 11th March 2020 the World Health Organisation (WHO) declared to be a pandemic; at the time of the publication of the Civil Contingencies Emergency (Coronavirus) (Businesses, Restrictions and Other Matters) (No.13) Regulations 2022 there were more than 426,624,859 confirmed cases globally and more than 5,899,578 people had died; at the time of the publication of these Regulations there were more than 437,333,859 confirmed cases globally and more than 5,960,972 people have died; Coronavirus has, to date, reached 235 countries, areas or territories, and it is therefore necessary to take measures to prevent, mitigate and control the spread of Coronavirus in Gibraltar;
- (b) the conditions in section 12 of the Act are met;
- (c) these Regulations contain only provisions which are appropriate for the purpose of preventing, controlling or mitigating an aspect or effect of the emergency in respect of which the Regulations are made; and
- (d) the effect of these Regulations is in due proportion to that aspect or effect of the said emergency.

**Amendment to the Civil Contingencies Emergency (Coronavirus) (Businesses, Restrictions and Other Matters) (No.13) Regulations 2022.**

4.(1) The Civil Contingencies Emergency (Coronavirus) (Businesses, Restrictions and Other Matters) (No.13) Regulations 2022 are amended in accordance with this regulation.

(2) In regulation 4—

- (a) delete the definition of “fully vaccinated”;
- (b) delete the definition of “public service vehicle”; and
- (c) delete the definition of “vaccine”.

(3) Delete regulations 5 and 6.

(4) In regulation 7(1), for “dental services, opticians, chiropractors, osteopaths or other medical or health services” substitute “medical or dental services”.

(5) Delete regulation 8.

(6) In regulation 9, for “regulations 5, 6, 7 and 8” substitute “regulation 7”.

(7) Delete regulations 10, 11, 12, 14, 15 and 16.

(8) Delete the Schedule.
