3. A person making application under section 2A of the Act for re-appointment as a Commissioner for Oaths shall make application to the Registrar giving the information specified in Schedule 2, together with the fee specified in Schedule 4.

Application for registration as a Public Notary.

4. A person making application under section 7 of the Act for registration as a Public Notary shall make application to the Registrar giving the information specified in Part I of Schedule 3, together with the fee specified in Schedule 4.

Application for re-registration as a Public Notary.

5. A person making application under section 7 of the Act for re-registration as a Public Notary shall apply to the Registrar giving the information specified in Part II of Schedule 4, together with the fee specified in Schedule 4.
