**2026/077 Communications (Temporary Exemption from Part 4A)
Regulations 2026**

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Minister by section 9(2)(d) of the Communications Act 2006, the Minister has made these Regulations—

Title.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Communications (Temporary Exemption from Part 4A) Regulations 2026.

Commencement.

2. These Regulations come into operation on the day of publication.

Interpretation.

3. In these Regulations—

“beneficial owner” means the individual who owns or controls a corporate body, whether by direct or indirect ownership of shares, voting rights or any other means;

“officer” means a director or the secretary of a company or any employee of the company and includes any person in accordance with whose directions or instructions the directors of the company are accustomed to act;

“specified person” means a person named in the Schedule who is temporarily exempted from the provisions of Part 4A of the Act.

Overview.

4.(1) These Regulations provide for the temporary exemption of specified persons from the provisions of Part 4A of the Act.

(2) Where the specified person is a company, the temporary exemption from the provisions of Part 4A extends to any individual who is a beneficial owner or officer of the company.

Exemptions.

5.(1) A specified person named in the Schedule to these Regulations shall be temporarily exempt from the provisions of Part 4A of the Act.

(2) Any extant regulatory or legal proceedings or sanction imposed by the Authority under Part 4A in respect of a specified person named in the Schedule shall be suspended for the duration of the temporary exemption.

- (3) A temporary exemption shall be effective from the date stipulated in the Schedule.
- (4) The Minister may by Order vary or revoke a temporary exemption.
