**GIBRALTAR COURT OF APPEAL ACT.
(Cap. 170).**

GIBRALTAR COURT OF APPEAL (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1984.

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 7 of the Gibraltar Court of Appeal Act and of all other powers thereunto him enabling, the President of the Court of Appeal has made the following rules of court: -

Title.

1. These rules may be cited as the Gibraltar Court of Appeal (Amendment) Rules 1984.

Amendment of rule 17.

2. Rule 17 of the Gibraltar Court of Appeal Rules 1970 is amended by revoking subrule (6) thereof and substituting the following: -

"(6) Where a person aggrieved by a decision of a single judge desires -

- (a) under section 9 of the Act, to have the order made by the judge discharged or varied by the court; or
- (b) under section 16 of the Act, to have the application determined by the court,

he shall give notice of such desire informally to the judge at the time when the decision is given or by writing to the Registrar within seven days thereafter.

(6A) A person who has given notice under subrule (6) shall, within fourteen days thereafter, file two extra copies of the proceedings, including any affidavits filed by any other party prior to the giving of notice, and two copies of the notice, if it was in writing, for the use of the court."
