GIBRALTAR COURT OF APPEAL (AMENDMENT) RULES

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 7 of the Gibraltar Court of Appeal Act, and of all other powers thereunto him enabling, the President of the Court of Appeal has made the following rules of court

Title.

1. These rules may be cited as the Gibraltar Court of Appeal (Amendment) Rules 1985.

Amendment of rule 56.

2. Rule 56 of the Gibraltar Court of Appeal Rules 1970 is amended—

- (a) by deleting from subrule (1) the words "such grounds to be numbered consecutively" and substituting therefor "and the nature of the order which it is proposed to ask the court to make";
- (b) by inserting a new subrule, to be numbered (1A), immediately after subrule (1), as follows -
"(1A). The grounds of objection shall be numbered consecutively. "
