COURT OF APPEAL ACT.

COURT OF APPEAL (FEES) (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1989.

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 8A of the Court of Appeal Act and of all other enabling powers, the President of the Court of Appeal has made the following rules.

Title and commencement.

1. These rules may be cited as the Court of Appeal (Fees) (Amendment) Rules, 1989 and shall come into operation on 1 March 1989.

New Schedule 2.

2. Schedule 2 to the Court of Appeal Rules is deleted and the following Schedule is substituted therefor

SCHEDULE 2.

FEES.

PART I.

Rule 12.

The fees and percentages set out in this Part of this Schedule and no others shall be taken and paid in respect of all civil causes, matters and proceedings in the court, and in respect of such applications and proceedings in the Supreme Court, preparatory or incidental to, or consequential upon, a civil appeal to the court, as are herein specified.

Provided that in all proceedings in the Supreme Court preparatory or incidental to an appeal to the court, or consequential thereon, the fees, if not hereinbefore specified, shall be in accordance with the provision of law applicable to the Supreme Court.
