SCHEDULE

Title.

1. These rules may be cited as the Magistrates' Court Rules.

Application of S.I. 1968 No. 1920.

2. The Magistrates' Courts Rules 1968 of the United Kingdom as amended from time to time shall apply in the magistrates' court in so far as they may be applicable thereto and with such modifications as the circumstances of Gibraltar may require.

Forms.

3. The forms, to be used in the magistrates' court shall be such forms as are from time to time in use in England in magistrates' courts for the same matters, subject to such modifications as are necessary to adapt such forms to the circumstances of Gibraltar and to such other modifications as the stipendiary magistrate may think fit to make thereto.

Fees.

4. The fees set out in the Schedule shall be payable in respect of the several matters to which they are expressed to relate.

10. For any other matter not prescribed above in respect of which any rules of court provide that a fee is payable	75 or such lower amount as the Clerk of the Magistrates' Court may in his discretion determine
