DRUGS (MISUSE) ORDINANCE

DRUGS (MISUSE) (FLUNITRAZEPAM) REGULATIONS 2006

The Government, in exercise of its powers under section 34 of the Drugs (Misuse) Ordinance, and all other enabling powers, makes the following Regulations, which will be laid before the House of Assembly—

Title.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Drugs (Misuse) (Flunitrazepam) Regulations 2006.

Amendment of the Drugs (Misuse) Regulations 2005.

2. The Schedules to the Drugs (Misuse) Regulations 2005 are amended as follows—

(a) in Schedule 2 paragraph 6, after “Fenethylline” insert “Flunitrazepam”; and

(b) in Schedule 3 paragraph (a), delete “Flunitrazepam”.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

On the advice of the Drugs Advisory Council, the Government has decided to reclassify flunitrazepam (commonly known by its trade name "rohypno") from a schedule 3 drug to a schedule 2 drug. The effect of this is to tighten the controls on the drug including controls as to importation and record keeping.
