In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 275 of the Criminal Offences Act, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has issued the following Notice –

Title.

1. This Notice may be cited as the Criminal Offences (Disposal of Proceeds of Sale) Notice 1991.

Sale of boat or trailer.

2.(1) Where in exercise of the powers conferred by section 275(2) of the Criminal Offences Act, a Police Officer has removed or caused to be removed any boat or trailer for a boat, and the expense of removal and detention have not been paid within the prescribed period of seven days, the Commissioner of Police, or any person authorised by him for this purpose to act as his agent, before exercising the power of sale or disposition contained in that section–

- (a) shall cause notice to be published in the Gazette of his intention to sell or otherwise dispose of or have sold or otherwise disposed of, such boat or trailer for a boat;
- (b) may, at any time after the expiry of seven days immediately following the date of publication of the notice, sell or otherwise

dispose of or cause to be sold or otherwise disposed of, such boat or trailer for a boat.

(2) Where a sale or disposition takes place in accordance with subparagraph (1)–

- (a) the proceeds (if any) of the sale or other disposition, shall be applied first towards the recouping of all expense in respect of the removal of the vehicle and to the expense of selling or otherwise disposing of the vehicle;
- (b) subject to sub-paragraph (3) the balance (if any) of the proceeds of the sale or other disposition, shall be paid to the person to whom, but for the sale or other disposition, the boat or trailer for the boat would have belonged at the time of the sale or other disposition.

(3) Where no person who is entitled to any surplus to which subparagraph (2)(b) refers claims such surplus within a period of one month immediately following the sale or other disposition, the surplus, in the case of a sale or disposition by the Commissioner of Police, shall be paid into the Police Reward Fund established by the Police Act or, in the case of a sale or disposition by a person authorised in accordance with paragraph 2(1), shall be retained by such person.
