NOTICE OF AMENDMENT (NO.28)

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by Paragraph 3(4) of the Ukraine Sanctions (No. 2) Order 2014, for the purposes of implementing Council Implementing Regulation (EU) 2019/409 of 14 March 2019 implementing Regulation (EU) No 269/2014 of 17 March 2014 concerning restrictive measures in respect of actions undermining or threatening the territorial integrity, sovereignty and independence of Ukraine, I have issued the following Notice-
