GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT, 1990

ISSUE OF "JAPANESE EMPEROR" COIN NOTICE, 1990

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has issued the following notice—

Title.

1. This notice may be cited as the "Japanese Emperor" Coin Notice, 1990.

Issue of new coins.

- 2. (1) New coins of gold in the denomination of £1,500, £100, £50, £20 and £10 shall be made.
- (2) In the making of the said coins the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part 3 to the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.
- (3) In the making of the said coins a remedy (that is a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Schedule.

Design of the coins.

- 3. The design of the coins authorised by this notice shall be as follows—
 - (a) all coins shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth 11 with the inscription "ELIZABETH II" to the left and the inscription "GIBRALTAR" and the date of the year to the right;
 - (b) the reverse impression shall bear one of the following two designs

- (i) a representation of the Nija Bashi Bridge in the garden of the Royal Palace in Tokyo with the inscription "Accession of 125th Emperor Akihito ' and the value of the coin in pounds; or
- (ii) a representation of the Niju Bashi Bridge in the garden of the Royal Palace in Tokyo with two Cranes flying above the bridge and the inscription "Accession of 125th Emperor Akihito" and the value of the coin in pounds.
