ISSUE OF ROTARY INTERNATIONAL COIN 1991NOTICE, 1991

In exercise the Powers conferred upon him by Section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990 and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has issued the following notice —

Title

1. This notice may be cited as the Rotary International Coin 1991 Notice, 1991.

Issue of new coins.

2. (1) New coins in platinum gold, palladium, silver and cupro nickel in the denomination of one Crown and thereof shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part II of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990.

(3) I n the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Schedule.

Design of the coins.

3. The design of the coins authorised by this notice shall be as follows —

(a) the obverse impression shall have the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription "ELIZABETH II" to the left and the inscription "GIBRALTAR" and the date of the year to the right;

(b) the reverse impression shall have the globe of the world with the Rotary wheel on top with the inscription "ROTARY INTERNATIONAL" around the wheel and the inscription

"SERVICE ABOVE SELF PRESERVE PLANET EARTH" and the value of the coin.

Legal Tender

The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
