GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT 1990.

ISSUE OF £10/14 ECU CIRCULATING AND COMMEMORATIVE COINS NOTICE 1992.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has issued the following notice-

Title.

l. This notice may be cited as the Issue of £10/ 14 ECU Circulating and Commemorative Coin Notice 1992.

Issue of new coins.

2.(1) New coins of silver in the denomination of £10, 14 ECU shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be-

- (a) in respect of the circulating coin as set out in Part IV of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990;
- (b) in respect of the commemorative coin as set out in Part V of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Schedules.

Design of the coins.

3. The design of the circulating and commemorative coins authorised by this notice shall be as follows-

GIBRALTAR GAZETTE, No. 2,660, Thursday 12th March, 1992.

- (a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription "ELIZABETH II" to the left and the inscription "GIBRALTAR" and the date of the year to the right;
- (b) the coins shall bear on the reverse impression the design of a Knight in Armour riding on his horse with twelve stars round the diameter of the coin and the value of $\pm 10/14$ ECU.

Legal tender.

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
