GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT 1990.

ISSUE OF ROYAL COIN (NO. 2) NOTICE 1992.

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990 and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has issued the following notice-

Title.

1. This notice may be cited as the Issue of Royal Coin (No. 2) Notice 1992.

Issue of new coins.

2.(1) New coins in gold, in the denomination of one Royal and thereof, and in silver and cupro nickel, in the denomination of one Crown, shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or compositions of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part VI of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standard weight), shall be allowed as set out in the said Schedule.

Design of the coins.

3. The design of the coins authorised by this notice shall be as follows-

(a) the coins shall bear in the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II, with the inscription "ELIZABETH II" to the left and the inscription "GIBRALTAR" and the date of the year to the right;

(b) the reverse impression shall have-

(i) the head of a Spaniel dog with the Castle and Keys of Gibraltar in the background; or

(ii) the head of a Peckinese with the Castle and Keys at Gibraltar in the foreground; or

(iii) the head of a Standard Poodle dog with the Castle and Keys of Gibraltar in the background; or

(iv) the head of a German Shepherd dog with the Castle and Keys of Gibraltar in the background; or

(v) the head of an Afgan dog with the Castle and Keys of Gibraltar in the background; or

(vi) the head of a Daschund dog with the Castle and Keys of Gibraltar in the background,

(vii) the head of a Borzoi dog with the Castle and Keys of Gibraltar in the background,

together with the inscription "ROYAL" and the value of the coin.

Legal Tender.

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
