**GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT, 1990.**

**ISSUE OF JAPANESE ROYAL WEDDING COINS NOTICE 1993.**

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has issued the following notice-

**Title.**

1. This notice may be cited as the Issue of Japanese Royal Wedding Coins Notice 1993.

**Issue of new coins.**

2.(1) New coins of platinum, gold, silver and cupro nickel in the denomination of a Crown and denominations thereof shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part II of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

**Design of the coins.**

3. The design of the coins authorised by this notice shall be as follows-

- (a) each coin shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription "ELIZABETH II" to the left and the inscription "GIBRALTAR" and the date of the year to the right;
- (b) the reverse impression shall bear the design of-

(i) the representation of two peacocks and the inscription "ROYAL WEDDING PRINCE NARUHITO PRINCESS MASAKO" and the value of the coin; or

(ii) the representation of two peacocks sitting side by side on a branch with the inscription "ROYAL WEDDING PRINCE NARUHITO PRINCESS MASAKO" and the value of the coin; or

(iii) the representation of one peacock standing with his tail open and the other peacock with the tail closed and the inscription "ROYAL WEDDING PRINCE NARUHITO PRINCESS MASAKO" and the value of the coin.

**Legal tender.**

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
