# ISSUE OF PRESERVE PLANET EARTH COINS (NO. 2) NOTICE, 1993.

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990 and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has issued the following notice-

#### Title.

 This notice may be cited as the Issue of Preserve Planet Earth Coins (No. 2) Notice, 1993.

#### Issue of new coins.

2.(1) New coins of platinum, gold,, silver and cupro nickel in the denomination of a Crown and denominations thereof shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part II of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is, a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as, set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

## Design of the coins.

3. The design of the coins authorised by this notice shall be as follows-

- (a) the coin shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription "ELIZABETH II" to the left and 'the inscription "GIBRALTAR" and the date of the year to the right;
- (b) the reverse impression of the coin shall bear either-

(i) the design of a Lynx with the inscription "PRESERVE PLANET EARTH" and the value of the coin; or

(ii) the design of four Ibexes on the rocks with the inscription "PRESERVE PLANET EARTH" and the value of the coin; or

(iii) the design of a Tropic bird lying in the foreground with two Tropic birds in flight in the background with the inscription "PRESERVE PLANET EARTH" and the value of the coin; or

(iv) the design of a Barbary Ape with her young with the inscription "PRESERVE PLANET EARTH" and the value of the coin; or

(v) the design of a Leopard lying on a branch with her young with the inscription "PRESERVE PLANET EARTH" and the value of the coin; or

(vi) the design of the face of a White Rhinocerous with the inscription "PRESERVE PLANET EARTH" and the value of the coin; or

(vii) the design of a Mediterranean Monk Seal with the inscription "PRESERVE PLANET EARTH" and the value of the coin; or

(viii) the design of two Puffins with the inscription "PRESERVE PLANET EARTH" and the value of the coin; or

(ix) the design of two Shags standing looking over the sea with one in flight in the nackground with the inscription "PRESERVE PLANET EARTH" and the value of the coin; or

(x) the design of one Marbled Teal with one in flight in the background with the inscription "PRESERVE PLANET EARTH" and the value of the coin; or GIBRALTAR GAZETTE, No. 2,743, Thursday 16th September, 1993.

(xi) the design of a Striped Dolphin's head in the foreground with two jumping in the background with the inscription "PRESERVE PLANET EARTH" and the value of the coin; or

(xii) the design of the head of a Fin Whale with the inscription "PRESERVE PLANET EARTH" and the value of the coin; or

(xiii) the design of a Sperm Whale with the inscription "PRESERVE PLANET EARTH" and the value of the coin; or

(xiv) the design of a Spanish Imperial Eagle in flight with the inscription "PRESERVE PLANET EARTH" and the value of the coin; or

(xv) the design of an African Elephany with her calf with the inscription "PRESERVE PLANET EARTH" and the value of the coin; or

(xvi) the design of a Sabre-toothed Tiger with the inscription "PRESERVE PLANET EARTH SABRE-TOOTHED TIGER" and the value of the coin.

## Legal Tender.

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
