GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT, 1990.

ISSUE OF WORLD WAR II COINS NOTICE, 1994.

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has issued the following notice -

Title.

1. This notice may be; cited as the Issue of World War II Coins Notice, 1994.

Issue of new coins.

- 2.(1) New coins of platinum, gold, silver and cupro nickel in the denomination of a Crown and denominations thereof shall he made.
- (2) In the making of the said coins, (he millesimal fineness or composition of metals diameters shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part 11 of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.
- (3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is, a variation from the standard weight) shall lx; allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

Design of the coins.

- 3. The design of the coins authorised by this notice shall he as follows -
 - (a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription "ELIZABETH II" to the left and the inscription "GIBRALTAR" and the date of the year to tile right;
 - (b) the coins shall bear on the reverse impression the design of -
 - (i) a portrait of King George VI meeting pilots on the Gibraltar runway together with the inscriptions

"WORLD WAR II" and "KING GEORGE VI MEETS PILOTS" and the value of the coin;

- (ii) a portrait of Adminral Somerville with the aircraft carrier the Ark Royal passing the Rock of Gibraltar together with the inscriptions "WORLD WAR II" and "ADMIRAL SOMERVILLE" and the value of the coin:
- (iii) a portrait of Glen Miller with people dancing in the background together with the inscriptions "WORLD WAR II" and "GLEN MILLER" and the value of the coin;
- (iv) a portrait of General Eisenhower with a landing boat in the background and "blimps" in the sky together with the inscriptions "WORLD WAR II, GENERAL EISENHOWER" and "SUPREME ALLIED COMMANDER" and the value of the coin;
- (v) a Squadron 202 aircraft with Gibraltar in the background and the Squadron badge above together with the inscriptions "WORLD WAR II" and "SQUADRON 202 IN GIBRALTAR" and the value of the coin.
- (vi) a convoy of damaged ships entering Valetta Grand Harbour Malta with the inscriptions "WORLD WAR II" and "MALTESE CONVOY" together with the value of the coin.

Legal tender.

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
