GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT 1990

ISSUE OF CENTENNIAL OLYMPICS COIN NOTICE 1995

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has issued the following notice -

1. Title.

This notice may be cited as the Issue of Centennial Olympics Coin Notice 1995.

2. Issue of new coins.

(1) New coins of platinum, gold, silver and mixed metal in the denomination of £5 shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part 1 of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is, a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

3. Design of the coins.

The design of the coins authorised by this notice shall be as follows -

- (a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription "ELIZABETH II" to the left and the inscription "GIBRALTAR" and the date of the year to the right;

- (b) the reverse impression shall bear the design of a portrait of Zeus on his throne with the Olympics flame at his feet and surrounded by a design taken from original Greek drawings of athletes with the inscription "CENTENNIAL OLYMPICS" together with the value of the coin.

4. Legal tender.

The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
