GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT 1990

ISSUE OF SYDNEY SUMMER OLYMPICS COIN NOTICE 1995

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990 and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has issued the following notice -

Title.

1. This notice may be cited as the Issue of Sydney Summer Olympics Coin Notice 1995.

Issue of new coins.

2.(1) New coins of platinum, gold, silver and cupro nickel in the denomination of a Crown and denominations thereof, shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part II of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is, a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

Design of the coins.

3. The designs of the coins authorised by this notice shall be as follows -

- (a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription "ELIZABETH II" to the left and the inscription "GIBRALTAR" and the date of the year to the right;

- (b) the reverse impression shall bear the design of -
- (i) a duck-billed platypus in the foreground with the Sydney Opera House in the background with the inscription "SUMMER OLYMPICS SYDNEY" and the value of the coin; or
 - (ii) an Aboriginal holding a flame in the foreground together with a Dingo and with spear throwers in the background with the inscription "SUMMER OLYMPICS SYDNEY" and the value of the coin; or
 - (iii) a runner and a portrait of an aboriginal in the foreground with the Ulara (Ayers Rock) and the sun setting in the background with the inscription "SUMMER OLYMPICS SYDNEY" and the value of the coin; or
 - (iv) a long jumper in the foreground with a kangaroo with her joey in the background with the inscription "SUMMER OLYMPICS SYDNEY" and the value of the coin; or
 - (v) a koala on a tree above with a swimmer below with the inscription "SUMMER OLYMPICS SYDNEY" and the value of the coin or
 - (vi) two cockatoos above with two rowers below with the inscription "SUMMER OLYMPICS SYDNEY" and the value of the coin.

Legal Tender.

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
