**GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT 1990**

**ISSUE OF CENTENARY OF THE CINEMA COIN NOTICE 1995**

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has issued the following notice –

**Title.**

1. This notice may be cited as the Issue of Centenary of the Cinema Coin Notice 1995.

**Issue of new coins.**

2. (1) New coins of platinum, gold, silver and cupro nickel in the denomination of a Crown and denominations thereof, shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part II of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is, a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

**Design of the coins.**

3. The design of the coins authorised by this notice shall be as follows –

- (a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription “ELIZABETH II” to the left and the inscription “GIBRALTAR” and the date of the year to the right;

- (b) the reverse impression shall bear the design of –
- (i) a portrait of Marilyn Monroe with the inscriptions “1895 CENTENARY OF THE CINEMA 1995” and “MARILYN MONROE 1926-1962” and the value of the coin; or
  - (ii) a Jazz Singer abstractly drawn as taken from the original poster with the inscriptions “1895 CENTENARY OF THE CINEMA 1995” and “AL JOLSON THE JAZZ SINGER” and the value of the coin; or
  - (iii) Audrey Hepburn in My Fair Lady with the inscriptions “1895 CENTENARY OF THE CINEMA 1995” and “AUDREY HEPBURN 1929-1993” and “MY FAIR LADY” and the value of the coin; or
  - (iv) the Wizard of OZ with the inscriptions “1895 CENTENARY OF THE CINEMA 1995” and “THE WIZARD OF OZ” and the value of the coin; or
  - (v) Charlie Chaplin with the inscriptions “1895 CENTENARY OF THE CINEMA 1995” and “CHARLIE CHAPLIN 1889-1977” and the value of the coin; or
  - (vi) Bruce Lee with a dragon in the background with the inscriptions “1895 CENTENARY OF THE CINEMA 1995” and “BRUCE LEE 1940-1973” and “ENTER THE DRAGON” and the value of the coin; or
  - (vii) the Marx Brothers with the inscriptions “1895 CENTENARY OF THE CINEMA 1995” and “THE MARX BROTHERS” and the value of the coin; or
  - (viii) ET with the inscriptions “1895 CENTENARY OF THE CINEMA 1995” and “E.T.” and the value of the coin; or

- (ix) Scarlet O'Hara and Rhett Butler as portrayed on the poster of "Gone with the Wind" with the inscriptions "1895 CENTENARY OF THE CINEMA 1995" and "GONE WITH THE WIND" and the value of the coin; or
- (x) Elvis Presley with the inscriptions "1895 CENTENARY OF THE CINEMA 1995" and "ELVIS PRESLEY 1935-1977" and the value of the coin; or
- (xi) a portrait of Grace Kelly with the inscriptions "1895 CENTENARY OF THE CINEMA 1995" and "GRACE KELLY 1929-1982" and the value of the coin; or
- (xii) James Dean with the inscriptions "1895 CENTENARY OF THE CINEMA 1995" and "JAMES DEAN 1931-1955" and the value of the coin; or
- (xiii) a portrait of Alfred Hitchcock with a bird on his shoulder with the inscriptions "1895 CENTENARY OF THE CINEMA 1995" and "ALFRED HITCHCOCK 1899-1980" and the value of the coin; or
- (xiv) Rick and Ilsa from Casablanca with the inscriptions "1895 CENTENARY OF THE CINEMA 1995" and "CASABLANCA" and the value of the coin; or
- (xv) Laurel and Hardy with the inscriptions "1895 CENTENARY OF THE CINEMA 1995" and "STAN, OLLIE", and "LAUREL AND HARDY" and "1890-1965, 1892-1957" and the value of the coin; or
- (xvi) the Flintstones with the inscriptions "1895 CENTENARY OF THE CINEMA 1995" and "THE FLINTSTONES" and the value of the coin; or

- (xvii) Yujiro Ishihara with the inscriptions “1895 CENTENARY OF THE CINEMA 1995” and “YUJIRO ISHIHARA 1934-1987” and “ALONE IN THE PACIFIC” and the value of the coin.

**4. Legal Tender.**

The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
