GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT 1990

ISSUE OF UNA AND THE LION COIN NOTICE 1996

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has issued the following notice —

Title and commencement.

1. This notice may be cited as the Issue of Una and the Lion Coin Notice 1996 and shall have effect in respect of coins issued on or after the date of publication of this notice in the Gazette.

Issue of new coins.

2. (1) New coins of platinum, gold, silver and cupro nickel in the denomination of five pounds, two pounds and fifty pence, one sovereign, half sovereign and quarter sovereign shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Table 2 of Part III of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is, a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Table in that Part of the Schedule.

Design of the coins.

3. The design of the coins authorised by this notice shall be as follows —

(a) each coin shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription "ELIZABETH" to the left and the inscription "GIBRALTAR" and the date of the year to the right;

(b) each coin shall bear on the reverse impression the design of a lion standing holding the key of Gibraltar in its front paw and a female allegorical figure holding the orb and sceptre with the inscription "MONETAE REGIAE GIBRALTARICA" above and the inscription of the date of the year in Latin below with a surrounding border.

Legal tender.

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
