## GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT 1990

### 80TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE ROYAL AIR FORCE £5 COIN NOTICE, 1998

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990, and of all other enabling powers, I have issued the following notice –

#### **Title.**

1. This notice may be cited as the 80th Anniversary of the Royal Air Force £5 Coin Notice, 1998.

#### **Issue of new coins.**

2.(1) New coins of platinum, gold, silver and mixed metal in the denomination of £5 shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part I of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is, a variation of the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

#### **Design of the coins.**

3. The design of the coins authorised by this notice shall be as follows –

- (a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription “ELIZABETH II” to the right and the inscription “GIBRALTAR” to the left and the date of the year below;
- (b) the reverse impression shall bear the design of the aircraft “Eurofighter” superimposed on an outline map of Europe

together with 12 stars representative of the European Union and the inscription "80th ANNIVERSARY OF THE RAF" and the value of the coin.

**Legal tender.**

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
