GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT 1990

MILLENNIUM 2000 COIN NOTICE 1999

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has issued the following notice -

Title

1. This notice may be cited as the Millennium 2000 Coin Notice 1999.

Issue of new coins

2.(1) New coins of platinum, gold, silver and mixed metal in the denomination of -

- (a) £5; and
- (b) a Crown and denominations thereof,

shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out, in the case of coins in the denomination of £5, in Part I of the Schedule and, in the case of coins in the denomination of a Crown and denominations thereof, in Part II to the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is, a variation of the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Parts of the Schedule.

Design of the coins

3. The design of the coins authorised by this notice shall be as follows -
 - (a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression -

- (i) in the case of coins in the denomination of £5, the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription “ELIZABETH II” to the right and the inscription “GIBRALTAR” to the left and the date of the year below; and
 - (ii) in the case of coins in the denomination of a Crown and denominations thereof, the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription “ELIZABETH II” to the left and the inscription “GIBRALTAR” and the date of the year to the right;
- (b) the reverse impression shall bear the design depicting the evolution of the method of determining time, with a sun dial in the upper right quarter, a candle in the lower left quarter, the face of an analogue clock in the upper left quarter with the Millennium logo superimposed and a digital clock in the lower right quarter together with the inscription “MILLENNIUM 2000” and the value of the coin.

Legal tender

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
