GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT 1990

TWO PENNY BLUE 160TH ANNIVERSARY COIN NOTICE 2000

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has issued the following notice -

Title.

1. This notice may be cited as the Two Penny Blue 160th Anniversary Coin Notice, 2000.

Issue of new coins.

- 2.(1) New coins of -
 - (a) titanium in the denomination of £5; and
 - (b) gold and titanium in the denomination of a Crown and denominations thereof as herein specified,

shall be made.

- (2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out, in the case of coins in the denomination of £5, in Part I of the Schedule and, in the case of coins in the denomination of a Crown and denominations thereof, in Part II to the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990.
- (3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is, a variation of the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Parts of the Schedule.

Design of the coins.

- 3. The design of the coins authorised by this notice shall be as follows-
 - (a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression -

- (i) in the case of coins in the denomination of £5, the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription "ELIZABETH II" to the right and the inscription "GIBRALTAR" to the left and the date of the year below; and
- (ii) in the case of coins in the denomination of a Crown and denominations thereof, the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription "ELIZABETH II" to the left and the inscription "GIBRALTAR" and the date of the year to the right;
- (b) the reverse impression shall bear the design of the Two Pence Stamp together with the inscription "160TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE UNIFORM PENNY POST" and the value of the coin.

Legal tender.

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
