LEGAL NOTICE NO. 20 OF 2001

GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT 1990

ISSUE OF ROYAL COIN NOTICE 2001 (NO. 2)

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990, and of all other enabling powers, I have issued the following notice—

Title.

1. This notice may be cited as the Issue of Royal Coin Notice 2001 (No.2).

Issue of new coins.

- 2.(1) New coins gold in the denomination of one Royal and denominations thereof shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness, or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part VI of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is, a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

Design of the Coins.

3. The design of the coins authorised by this notice shall be as follows—
 - (a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription “ELIZABETH II” to the left and the inscription “GIBRALTAR” and the date of the year to the right;
 - (b) the reverse impression shall bear the design of two cherub angels with bows and arrows from the painting in the Palazzo

dala Fanesina, Rome “The Triumph of Galatea” by Raphael Sanzio together with the value of the coin.

Legal Tender.

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
