LEGAL NOTICE NO. 45 OF 2001.

GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT 1990 FOOTBALL WORLD CUP, JAPAN AND KOREA, 2002 CROWN COIN NOTICE 2001.

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has issued the following notice—

Title.

1. This notice may be cited as the Football World Cup, Japan and Korea, 2002 Crown Coin Notice 2001.

Issue of new coins.

2.(1) New coins of platinum, gold, silver and cupro nickel in the denomination of a Crown and denominations thereof shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness, or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part II of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is, a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

Design of the coins.

3. The design of the coins authorised by this notice shall be as follows—

- (a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription “ELIZABETH II” to the left and the inscription “GIBRALTAR” and the date of the year to the right;
- (b) the reverse impression shall bear the design of—

- (i) two footballers in a tackle for possession of the ball together with the inscription “WORLD CUP. JAPAN & KOREA. 2002” and the value of the coin; or
- (ii) two footballers challenging for possession of the ball together with the inscription “WORLD CUP. JAPAN & KOREA. 2002” and the value of the coin; or
- (iii) two footballers, with the footballer in the foreground executing an ‘overhead/scissors kick’ together with the inscription “WORLD CUP. JAPAN & KOREA. 2002” and the value of the coin; or
- (iv) two footballers, a defender and, in the foreground, a forward taking a goal shot together with the inscription “WORLD CUP. JAPAN & KOREA. 2002” and the value of the coin.

Legal Tender.

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
