GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT, 1990

ISSUE OF ALLIED VICTORY 5-OUNCE COIN NOTICE, 2004

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has issued the following notice –

Title.

1. This notice may be cited as the Issue of Allied Victory 5-Ounce Coin Notice, 2004.

Issue of new coins.

2.(1) New coins of gold, silver and gold-plated silver in the denomination of £10 shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part III of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standards weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

Design of the coins.

3. The design of the coins authorised by this notice shall be as follows –

- (a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription “ELIZABETH II” to the left and the inscription “GIBRALTAR” and the date of the year to the right;

- (b) the reverse impression shall bear a design of the D-Day landings, featuring troops emerging from the back of the landing crafts on the Normandy beaches in June 1944, with the beach in the background. Included around the edge are the individual coloured flags of the twelve allied countries that took part in the operation: the United Kingdom, the United States of America, Australia, New Zealand, Norway, Greece, Belgium, France, Canada, the Netherlands, Poland, and Czechoslovakia with the inscription “D-DAY JUNE 6TH 1944” and the value of the coin.

Legal Tender.

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
