GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT, 1990

ISSUE OF THE RETURN TO ATHENS COLLECTION COIN NOTICE, 2004

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has issued the following notice –

Title.

1. This notice may be cited as the Issue of the Return to Athens Collection Coin Notice, 2004.

Issue of new coins.

2.(1) New coins of gold, silver and cupro-nickel in the denomination of $\pounds 5$ and crown shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part II and Part III of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is, a variation from the standards weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

Design of the coins.

3. The design of the coins authorised by this notice shall be as follows -

(a) each coin shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription "ELIZABETH II" to the left and the inscription "GIBRALTAR" and the date of the year to the right;

(b) the reverse impression shall bear –

(i) a design that features two athletes running, with the Parthenon in the background. The national flag of Greece is shown in colour. Included on the coin are the inscriptions "RETURN TO ATHENS", "GREECE 1896" and the value of the coin;

(ii) a design that features two oarsmen, with the Houses of Parliament, St Paul's Cathedral, Nelson's Column and the Tower Bridge in the background. The national flag of the United Kingdom is shown in colour. Included on the coin are the inscriptions "RETURN TO ATHENS", "1908", "GREAT BRITAIN", "1948" and the value of the coin;

(iii) a design that features a cyclist, with the Eiffel Tower in the background. The national flag of France is shown in colour. Included on the coin are the inscriptions "RETURN TO ATHENS", "1900", "FRANCE", "1924" and the value of the coin;

(iv) a design that features four basketball players, with the Statue of Liberty in the background. The national flag of the United States of America is shown in colour. Included on the coin are the inscriptions "RETURN TO ATHENS", "1904", "1932", "UNITED STATES", "1984", "1996" and the value of the coin;

(v) a design that features three swimmers, with the Sydney Opera House in the background. The national flag of Australia is shown in colour. Included on the coin are the inscriptions "RETURN TO ATHENS", "1956", "AUSTRALIA", "2000" and the value of the coin;

(vi) a design that features two canoeists, with the Drottingholm Palace in the background. The national flag of Sweden is shown in colour. Included on the coin are the inscriptions "RETURN TO ATHENS", "SWEDEN", "1912" and the value of the coin;

(vii) a design that features an equestrian, with the Brandenburg Gate in the background. The national flag of Germany is shown in colour. Included on the coin are the inscriptions "RETURN TO ATHENS", "1936", "GERMANY", "1972" and the value of the coin;

(viii) a design that features an athlete throwing a javelin, with the Finlandia Hall in the background. The national flag of Finland is shown in colour. Included on the coin are the inscriptions "RETURN TO ATHENS", "FINLAND", "1952" and the value of the coin;

(ix) a design that features two baseball players, with the Tokyo Tower in the background. The national flag of Japan is shown in colour. Included on the coin are the inscriptions "RETURN TO ATHENS", "JAPAN", "1964" and the value of the coin;

(x) a design that features two sailors sailing in their boats, with the Magere Brug Bridge in the background. The national flag of the Netherlands is shown in colour. Included on the coin are the inscriptions "RETURN TO ATHENS", "HOLLAND", "1928" and the value of the coin;

(xi) a design that features two athletes running a relay race, with the CN Tower in the background. The national flag of Canada is shown in colour. Included on the coin are the inscriptions "RETURN TO ATHENS", "CANADA", "1976" and the value of the coin;

(xii) a design that features two fencers, with the Coliseum in the background. The national flag of Italy is shown in colour. Included on the coin are the inscriptions "RETURN TO ATHENS", "ITALY", "1960" and the value of the coin;

(xiii) a design that features two judokas, with the Grande Place in the background. The national flag of

Belgium is shown in colour. Included on the coin are the inscriptions "RETURN TO ATHENS", "BELGIUM", "1920" and the value of the coin;

(xiv) a design that features a weightlifter, with the Aztec Ruins in the background. The national flag of Mexico is shown in colour. Included on the coin are the inscriptions "RETURN TO ATHENS", "MEXICO", "1968" and the value of the coin;

(xv) a design that features two gymnasts, with the Kremlin in the background. The national flag of Russia is shown in colour. Included on the coin are the inscriptions "RETURN TO ATHENS", "RUSSIA", "1980" and the value of the coin;

(xvi) a design that features two archers, with the Hwasong Fortress in the background. The national flag of South Korea is shown in colour. Included on the coin are the inscriptions "RETURN TO ATHENS", "SOUTH KOREA", "1988" and the value of the coin;

(xvii) a design that features two hockey players, with the temple of La Sagrada Familia in the background. Included on the coin are the inscriptions "RETURN TO ATHENS", "SPAIN", "1992" and the value of the coin;

(xviii) a design that features two wrestlers, with the Acropolis in the background. The national flag of Greece is shown in colour. Included on the coin are the inscriptions "RETURN TO ATHENS", "GREECE", "2004" and the value of the coin;

Legal Tender.

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
