### **GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT, 1990**

# ISSUE OF 200<sup>th</sup> ANNIVERSARY OF THE BATTLE OF TRAFALGAR COIN NOTICE 2006

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has issued the following notice—

# Title.

1. This notice may be cited as the Issue of The 200<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Battle of Trafalgar Coin Notice 2006.

#### Issue of new coins.

- 2.(1) New coins of gold, silver and cupro-nickel in the denomination of £5, £1 and crown shall be made.
- (2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part II and Part III of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990.
- (3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standards weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

# Design of the coins.

- 3. The design of the coins authorised by this notice shall be as follows-
  - (a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription "ELIZABETH II" to the left and the inscription "GIBRALTAR" and the date of the year to the right;
  - (b) the reverse impression shall bear-

- (i) a design of 1805 featuring 'Race and Chase'. Included on the coin are the inscriptions "1805 TRAFALGAR 2005" and the value of the coin;
- (ii) a design featuring the Battle of Nile. Included on the coin are the inscriptions "1805 TRAFALGAR 2005" and the value of the coin;
- (iii) a design featuring Tenerife where Nelson lost his arm.
  Included on the coin are the inscriptions "1805
  TRAFALGAR 2005" and the value of the coin;
- (iv) a design featuring Nelson and Hardy on the deck of the HMS Victory. Included on the coin are the inscriptions "1805 TRAFALGAR 2005" and the value of the coin;
- (v) a design featuring the siege of Calvi where Nelson lost his eye. Included on the coin are the inscriptions "1805 TRAFALGAR 2005" and the value of the coin;
- (vi) a design featuring the Battle of Cape St Vincent. Included on the coin are the inscriptions "1805 TRAFALGAR 2005" and the value of the coin;
- (vii) a design featuring the siege of the Victory. Included on the coin are inscriptions "1805 TRAFALGAR 2005" and the value of the coin.

## Legal Tender.

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
