**GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT, 1990**

**ISSUE OF THE ENGLAND '66 COIN NOTICE 2006**

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has issued the following notice—

**Title.**

1. This notice may be cited as the Issue of The England '66 Coin Notice 2006.

**Issue of new coins.**

2.(1) New coins of gold, silver and cupro-nickel in the denomination of £10, £5 and crown shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part II and Part III of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standards weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

**Design of the coins.**

3. The design of the coins authorised by this notice shall be as follows—

- (a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription "ELIZABETH II" to the left and the inscription "GIBRALTAR" and the date of the year to the right;
- (b) the reverse impression shall bear—

- (i) a design featuring the Wembley Stadium. Included on the coin are the inscriptions “ENGLAND ‘66 – 40<sup>th</sup> ANNIVERSARY”, Bobby Moore’s signature and the value of the coin;
- (ii) a design featuring the crowds at the 1966 World Cup Final. Included on the coin are the inscriptions “ENGLAND ‘66 – 40<sup>th</sup> ANNIVERSARY”, Bobby Moore’s signature and the value of the coin;
- (iii) a design featuring Bobby Moore lifting the World Cup Trophy. Included on the coin are the inscriptions “ENGLAND ‘66 – 40<sup>th</sup> ANNIVERSARY”, Bobby Moore’s signature and the value of the coin;
- (iv) a design featuring Bobby Moore and Sir Alf Ramsey. Included on the coin are the inscriptions “ENGLAND ‘66 – 40<sup>th</sup> ANNIVERSARY”, Bobby Moore’s signature and the value of the coin;
- (v) a design featuring Her Majesty the Queen presenting the World Cup Trophy. Included on the coin are the inscriptions “ENGLAND ‘66 – 40<sup>th</sup> ANNIVERSARY”, Bobby Moore’s signature and the value of the coin;
- (vi) a design featuring the flags of England and Uruguay. Included on the coin are the inscriptions “ENGLAND ‘66 – 40<sup>th</sup> ANNIVERSARY”, Bobby Moore’s signature and the value of the coin;
- (vii) a design featuring the flags of England and Mexico. Included on the coin are the inscriptions “ENGLAND ‘66 – 40<sup>th</sup> ANNIVERSARY”, Bobby Moore’s signature, the date score, the venue of the match and the value of the coin;
- (viii) a design featuring the flags of England and France. Included on the coin are the inscriptions “ENGLAND ‘66 – 40<sup>th</sup> ANNIVERSARY”, Bobby Moore’s signature, the date score, the venue of the match and the value of the coin;

- (ix) a design featuring the flags of England and Argentina. Included on the coin are the inscriptions “ENGLAND ‘66 – 40<sup>th</sup> ANNIVERSARY”, Bobby Moore’s signature, the date score, the venue of the match and the value of the coin;
- (x) a design featuring the flags of England and Portugal. Included on the coin are the inscriptions “ENGLAND ‘66 – 40<sup>th</sup> ANNIVERSARY”, Bobby Moore’s signature, the date score, the venue of the match and the value of the coin;
- (xi) A design featuring the flags of England and West Germany. Included on the coin are the inscriptions “ENGLAND ‘66 – 40<sup>th</sup> ANNIVERSARY”, Bobby Moore’s signature, the date score, the venue of the match and the value of the coin.

**Legal Tender.**

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
