GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT, 1990

ISSUE OF THE HISTORY OF THE RAF COIN NOTICE 2009

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Minister responsible for Finance has issued the following notice—

Title.

1. This notice may be cited as the Issue of the History of the RAF Coin Notice 2009.

Issue of new coins.

2.(1) New coins of gold, silver, cupro-nickel and silver-plated cupro-nickel in the denomination of £10, £5, £1 and One Crown shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part II and Part III of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standards weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

Design of the coins.

3. The design of the coins authorised by this notice shall be as follows—

- (a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription “ELIZABETH II” to the left and the inscription “GIBRALTAR” and the date of the year to the right;
- (b) the reverse impression shall bear—

- (i) a design featuring the AVRO 504. The inscriptions include 'The History of the Royal Air Force', AVRO 504 and the value of the coin.
- (ii) a design featuring the Royal Aircraft Factory SE5a. The inscriptions include 'History of the Royal Air Force', RAF SE5a and the value of the coin.
- (iii) a design featuring the Airco DH9. The inscriptions include 'History of the Royal Air Force', Airco DH9 and the value of the coin.
- (iv) a design featuring the Vickers Vimy. The inscriptions include 'History of the Royal Air Force', Vickers Vimy and the value of the coin.
- (v) a design featuring the Hawker Hart. The inscription includes 'History of the Royal Air Force', Hawker Hart, and the value of the coin.
- (vi) a design featuring the Short Sunderland. The inscription includes 'History of the Royal Air Force', Short Sunderland and the value of the coin.
- (vii) a design featuring the Westland Lysander. The inscription includes 'History of the Royal Air Force', Westland Lysander, and the value of the coin.
- (viii) a design featuring the Bristol Beaufighter. The inscription includes 'History of the Royal Air Force', Bristol Beaufighter and the value of the coin.
- (ix) a design featuring the de Havilland Mosquito. The inscription includes 'History of the Royal Air Force', de Havilland Mosquito and the value of the coin.
- (x) a design featuring the Hawker Typhoon. The inscription includes 'History of the Royal Air Force', Hawker Typhoon and the value of the coin.

- (xi) a design featuring the English Electric Canberra. The inscription includes 'History of the Royal Air Force', English Electric Canberra and the value of the coin.
- (xii) a design featuring the Hawker Hunter. The inscription includes 'History of the Royal Air Force', Hawker Hunter and the value of the coin.
- (xiii) a design featuring the English Electric Lightning. The inscription includes 'History of the Royal Air Force', English Electric Lightning and the value of the coin.
- (xiv) a design featuring the Boeing C47 Chinook. The inscription includes 'History of the Royal Air Force', Boeing C47 Chinook and the value of the coin.
- (xv) a design featuring the Vickers VC 10. The inscription includes 'History of the Royal Air Force', Vickers VC10 and the value of the coin.
- (xvi) a design featuring the BAE Harrier Gr3. The inscription includes 'History of the Royal Air Force', BAE Harrier Gr3 and the value of the coin.
- (xvii) a design featuring the SEPECAT Jaguar. The inscription includes 'History of the Royal Air Force', SEPECAT Jaguar and the value of the coin.
- (xviii) a design featuring the Eurofighter Typhoon. The inscription includes 'History of the Royal Air Force', Eurofighter Typhoon and the value of the coin.

Legal Tender.

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
