GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT, 1990

**ISSUE OF FURTHER £15 CIRCULATING COINS – GIBRALTAR
SILVER ROYAL, NOTICE (2) 2014**

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Minister responsible for finance has issued the following notice–

Title.

1. This notice may be cited as the Issue of further £15 Circulating coins–Gibraltar Silver Royal, Notice (2) 2014.

Issue of new coins.

2.(1) Four new issues of coins in gold plated silver and silver in the denomination of £15 shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part I of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standards weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

Design of the coins.

3. The design of the coins authorised by this notice shall be as follows–

- (a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II together with the Rock of Gibraltar in the background, the value of the coin below this and the image of the sea with the inscription “ELIZABETH II” to the bottom left, the inscription “QUEEN OF GIBRALTAR” above and the date of the year below;

- (b) the reverse will depict the Coat of Arms. The inscription includes “GIBRALTAR SILVER ROYAL” and “1 Troy Ounce Ag 999”–
- (i) one coin issue will have the Coat of Arms in authentic colours,
 - (ii) one coin issue will feature a natural diamond set in the Coat of Arms. The diamond is a round natural diamond 1 point of a carat (0.01CT), colour H and quality VS,
 - (iii) one coin issue will have the Coat of Arms gold plated in 24 carat gold; and,
 - (iv) one coin issue will have the rim of the coin gold plated in 24 carat gold.

Legal Tender.

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
