**GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT, 1990**

**ISSUE OF THE QUEEN ELIZABETH II 90<sup>TH</sup> BIRTHDAY – PART 6,  
NOTICE 2016**

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Minister responsible for finance has issued the following notice–

**Title.**

1. This notice may be cited as issue of the coin to commemorate Queen Elizabeth II 90<sup>th</sup> Birthday – Part 6, notice 2016.

**Issue of new coins.**

2.(1) New coins of gold in the denominations of Quarter Sovereign, Half Sovereign, One Sovereign, Two Sovereigns and Five Sovereigns shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part VII of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Parts of the Schedule.

**Design of the coins.**

3. The design of the coins authorised by this notice shall be as follows–

(a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription “ELIZABETH II DEI GRA REGINA GIBRALTAR” bordering the top edge, and the date of the coin below.

(b) the reverse impressions shall bear;

- (i) Quarter Sovereign - a design depicting the number '90' in the centre, a floral design bordering the bottom and a crown at the top with the years '1926' and '2016' on either side.
- (ii) Half Sovereign - a design depicting four crowned cruciform shields with sceptres in angles. The year '1926' is shown at the top and the year '2016' at the bottom.
- (iii) One Sovereign - a design depicting four crowned cruciform shields with sceptres in angles and a crowned number '90' in the centre.
- (iv) Two Sovereign – a design depicting a woman riding a horse in the centre with the letters 'E' to the left and 'R' to the right. A crowned number '90' is shown at the top and the years 1926 and 2016 at the bottom.
- (v) Five Sovereigns – a design depicting a woman riding a horse in the centre with the years '1926' at the top and '2016' at the bottom. A floral design is shown bordering the bottom.

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
