GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT, 1990

**ISSUE OF THE BATTLE OF THE ATLANTIC CHURCHILL COIN –
PART 6, NOTICE 2017**

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Minister responsible for finance has issued the following notice–

Title.

1. This notice may be cited as issue of the coin to commemorate The Battle of the Atlantic Churchill – Part 6, Notice 2017.

Issue of new coins.

2.(1) New coins of silver in the denominations of Half Crown shall be made.

3. In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part II of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.

4. In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standards weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

Design of the coins.

5. The designs of the coins authorised by this notice shall be as follows –

- (a) the coin shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription “ELIZABETH II DEI GRA REGINA GIBRALTAR” bordering the top edge, and the value and date of the year below. A privy mark depicting an anchor will be shown to the lower left of the effigy.
- (b) the reverse impressions shall bear-

- (i) a design depicting a sailor looking through a pair of binoculars and a Merchant Navy ship on the top half and another sailor looking through a periscope and a submarine on the bottom half. The words “BATTLE OF THE ATLANTIC” are shown bordering the top edge and the years “1939 – 1945” bordering the bottom edge.
- (ii) a design depicting a Merchant Vessel breaking through icy waters in the background and a sailor operating a large light used for communication in the foreground. The words “BATTLE OF THE ATLANTIC” are shown bordering the top right and the years “1939 – 1945” bordering the bottom left.
- (iii) a design depicting a portrait of Franklin D Roosevelt with the American and Norwegian flags in the background and a Merchant vessel with the words “Look to Norway” in the foreground. The words “BATTLE OF THE ATLANTIC” are shown bordering the top left and the years “1939 – 1945” bordering the right.
- (iv) a design depicting a German bomber aircraft attacking a Merchant Convoy with the words “Battle of the North Cape” in the background and sailors operating a Royal Navy anti-aircraft gun in the foreground. The words “BATTLE OF THE ATLANTIC” are shown bordering the top and the years “1939 – 1945” bordering the left.

6. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar with effect from 13th January 2017.
