GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT, 1990

**ISSUE OF THE 100TH ANNIVERSARY OF WORLD WAR ONE
PART TWO COIN NOTICE 2018**

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Minister responsible for finance has issued the following notice—

Title and commencement.

1. This notice may be cited as the Issue of the 100th Anniversary of World War One Part Two Coin Notice 2018 and shall come into operation on the day of publication.

Issue of new coins.

2.(1) New coins of gold, silver, cupro nickel and tombac in the denomination of One Crown, 1/10 Crown, ¼ Crown, ½ Crown and Double Crown shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part II of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

Design of the coins.

3. The design of the coins authorised by this notice shall be as follows—

- (a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription “ELIZABETH II D G REGINA GIBRALTAR” bordering the top edge and the value and date of the year below;

- (b) the reverse impression shall bear a design of a lone soldier, head bowed looking towards a cross surrounded by a poppy, a daisy and a cornflower. The encircling inscription reads “1914 AT THE GOING DOWN OF THE SUN”;
- (c) the reverse impression shall bear a design depicting a scene from the outbreak of war when families were split up as soldiers left the safety of home. The encircling inscription reads “WE WILL REMEMBER THEM 1914-1918”;
- (d) the reverse impression shall bear a design depicting the fierce fighting from the trenches between Allied and Axis soldiers. The encircling inscription reads “WE WILL REMEMBER THEM 1914-1918”;
- (e) the reverse impression shall bear a design of two soldiers from Allied and Axis Forces, shaking hands while in the background two soldiers play a game of football. The encircling inscription reads “WE WILL REMEMBER THEM 1914-1918”;
- (f) the reverse impression shall bear a design depicting a tribute to the legacy of the young men of Britain and the Allied Forces who were hastily tried, convicted and faced firing squads for “cowardice” or “desertion”. The encircling inscription reads “WE WILL REMEMBER THEM 1914-1918”;
- (g) the reverse impression shall bear a design of a pilot dropping a bomb by hand and the Royal Flying Corps in the background. The encircling inscription reads “WE WILL REMEMBER THEM 1914-1918”;
- (h) the reverse impression shall bear a design representing the contribution of the Royal Navy during World War One. The encircling inscription reads “WE WILL REMEMBER THEM 1914-1918”.

Legal Tender.

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
