GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT, 1990

ISSUE OF THE ROYAL BABY PART ONE COIN NOTICE 2018

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Minister responsible for finance has issued the following notice–

Title.

1. This notice may be cited as the Issue of the Royal Baby Part One Coin Notice 2018.

Commencement.

2. This notice comes into operation on the day of publication.

Issue of new coins.

3.(1) New coins of gold and silver in the denomination of 1/10 Crown, 1/4 Crown, 1/2 Crown, One Crown, Double Crown, Quarter Sovereign, Half Sovereign, Sovereign, Two Sovereigns, Five Sovereigns and Five Pounds shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Parts II, III and VII of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

Design of the coins.

4. The design of the coins authorised by this notice shall be as follows–

- (a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription “ELIZABETH

II D G REGINA GIBRALTAR” bordering the top edge and the value and date of the year below;

- (b) the sovereign coin shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription “ELIZABETH II DE GRA REGINA GIBRALTAR” bordering the top edge and the date of the year below; and
- (c) the reverse impression shall bear a design depicting H.R.H. Prince William’s coat of arms and adjacent to this the Middleton family coat of arms. Protecting the shields are the lion and the unicorn. The encircling inscription reads “HRH PRINCE LOUIS OF CAMBRIDGE” with the date of the christening at the top.

Legal Tender.

- 5. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
