LEGAL NOTICE NO. 296 OF 2020

GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT, 1990

ISSUE OF THE WWII 80TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE OUTBREAK - PART FOUR - THE VOICE OF A NATION COINS NOTICE 2020

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990, and all other enabling powers, the Minister responsible for finance has issued the following Notice—

Title.

1. This Notice may be cited as the Issue of the WWII 80th Anniversary of The Outbreak - Part Four - The Voice of a Nation Coins Notice 2020.

Commencement.

2. This Notice comes into operation on the day of publication.

Issue of new coins.

3.(1) New coins of silver, gold, tombac and cupro nickel, in the denominations of 1/2 Crown, Crown and Two Crowns/Double Crown shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part II of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

Design of the coins.

4. The design of the coins authorised by this Notice shall be as follows—

- (a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II¹ with the inscription “ELIZABETH II D G REGINA GIBRALTAR” bordering the top edge, date of the year below;

- (b) the reverse impression depicts an image of a soldier with his sweetheart. The inner inscription reads “WE’LL MEET AGAIN, DON’T KNOW WHERE, DON’T KNOW WHEN”. The outer inscription reads “THE VOICE OF A NATION”;
- (c) the reverse impression depicts an image of a radio microphone with allied planes and ships heading into battle. The inner inscription reads “I PROMISE YOU, I’M SINCERELY YOURS”. The outer inscription reads “THE VOICE OF A NATION”;
- (d) the reverse impression depicts an image of an outdoor concert given to the troops. The inner inscription reads “FORGET ME NOT TODAY”. The outer inscription reads “THE VOICE OF A NATION”;
- (e) the reverse impression depicts an image of a singer at a concert together with the Burma Star. The inner inscription reads “YOURS ‘TILL THE STARS LOSE THEIR GLORY”. The outer inscription reads “THE VOICE OF A NATION”;
and
- (f) the reverse impression depicts an image of allied planes flying by the White Cliffs of Dover. The inner inscription reads “THERE’LL BE BLUEBIRDS OVER THE WHITE CLIFFS OF DOVER”. The outer inscription reads “THE VOICE OF A NATION”.

Legal Tender.

5. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
