GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT, 1990

ISSUE OF THE ROYAL AIR FORCE PART 7 – NORWEGIAN PILOTS – SQUADRONS COIN NOTICE 2020

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990, and all other enabling powers, the Minister responsible for finance has issued the following Notice—

Title.

1. This Notice may be cited as the Issue of the Royal Air Force Part 7 – Norwegian Pilots – Squadrons Coin Notice 2020.

Commencement.

2. This Notice comes into operation on the day of publication.

Issue of new coins.

- 3.(1) New coins of gold in the denominations of double/two crowns shall be made.
- (2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part II of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.
- (3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

Design of the coins.

- 4. The design of the coins authorised by this Notice shall be as follows-
 - (a) the coins shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription "ELIZABETH II D. G. REGINA GIBRALTAR" bordering the top edge, with the value and date of the coin below with the inscription "DOUBLE CROWN"; and

- (b) the reverse impression depicts an image of the RAF Badge 330 with the inscription "TRYGG HAVET". The outer inscription surrounding the coin includes the years "1940-1945" and the text reads "THEY FOUGHT FOR NORWAY IN FOREIGN SKIES":
- (c) the reverse impression depicts an image of the RAF Badge 331 with the inscription "FOR NORGE". The outer inscription surrounding the coin includes the years "1940-1945" and the text reads "THEY FOUGHT FOR NORWAY IN FOREIGN SKIES";
- (d) the reverse impression depicts an image of the RAF Badge 332 with the inscription "SAMHOLD I STRID". The outer inscription surrounding the coin includes the years "1940-1945" and the text reads "THEY FOUGHT FOR NORWAY IN FOREIGN SKIES"; and
- (e) the reverse impression depicts an image of the RAF Badge 333 with the inscription "FOR KONGE, FEDRELAND OG FLAGGETS HEDER". The outer inscription surrounding the coin includes the years "1940-1945" and the text reads "THEY FOUGHT FOR NORWAY IN FOREIGN SKIES".

Legal Tender.

5. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
