**ISSUE OF COINS IN CELEBRATION OF THE 10TH WEDDING
ANNIVERSARY OF THEIR ROYAL HIGHNESSES**

THE PRINCE AND PRINCESS OF WALES COIN NOTICE, 1991.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has issued the following Notice—

Title.

1. This Notice may be cited as the Celebration of the 10th Wedding Anniversary of Their Royal Highnesses the Prince and Princess of Wales Coin Notice, 1991.

Issue of new coins.

2. (1) New coins of platinum gold, palladium silver and cupro nickel in the denomination of one Crown and thereof shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins the metallurgical fineness or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part 2 of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act, 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins a remedy (that is a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Schedule.

Design of the coins.

3. The design of the coins authorised by this Notice shall be as follows

- (a) all coins shall bear in the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription "ELIZABETH

II" to the left and the inscription "GIBRALTAR" and the date of the year to the right;

(b) the reverse impression shall have the circumscription "10TH WEDDING ANNIVERSARY" with the value of the coin surrounding one of the following designs

- (i) His Royal Highness the Prince of Wales;
- (ii) Her Royal Highness the Princess of Wales;
- (iii) the Royal Yacht Britannia with Gibraltar in the background.

Legal tender.

4. The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
