**GIBRALTAR COINAGE ACT 1990**

**ISSUE OF REFURBISHMENT OF THE SYNAGOGUE COIN  
NOTICE 1995**

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1995, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has issued the following notice -

**1. Title.**

This notice may be cited as the Issue of Refurbishment of the Synagogue Coin Notice 1995.

**2. Issue of new coins.**

(1) New coins of platinum, gold, silver and cupro nickel in the denomination of a Crown and denominations thereof shall be made.

(2) In the making of the said coins, the millesimal fineness, or composition of metals, diameters, shapes and other specifications shall be as set out in Part II of the Schedule to the Gibraltar Coinage Act 1990.

(3) In the making of the said coins, a remedy (that is, a variation from the standard weight) shall be allowed as set out in the said Part of the Schedule.

**3. Design of the coin.**

The design of the coin authorised by this notice shall be as follows -

- (a) the coin shall bear on the obverse impression the effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II with the inscription "ELIZABETH II" to the left and the inscription "GIBRALTAR" and the date of the year to the right;
- (b) the reverse impression shall bear the symbol and the inscription in Hebrew and in English "L'HAYIM" and shall depict the Synagogue to the right and the Rock of Gibraltar to the left with the Castle and Keys in the centre together with the value of the coin.

**4. Legal tender.**

The said coins shall be current and legal tender in Gibraltar.
